We are going to join the Seminar Week of Studio Boltshauser at Brunnen led by Felix Hilgert to not only get theoretical insights but to work hands-on.

This week is an opportunity to engage deeply with the principles of regenerative practices in architecture, learning how to craft spaces that are both beautiful and environmentally responsible. Join us to explore, learn, and create.
